

# Roll Cage/Bar Fitment:


The R4 comes with 4 pairs of rubber inserts and 2 pair of Aluminum mounting bands.




# **MOUNTING**

**Step 1:** Remove Tower speaker from the packaging and ALL hardware

**Step 2:** Find a GOOD location that allows for easy wiring of the speakers - PLUS that it does NOT impair your movement around the location.

**Step 3:** Using a philips head screwdriver, remove the screw that holds the mounting band to the tower speakers.

**Step 4:** Measure the roll cage bar and use the included rubber insert that fits YOUR roll cage bar. Place the rubber insert onto the bar and then clip the band over the rubber insert.



**Step 5:** Slide the can speaker into the mounting band and line up the mounting hole. Insert the 1/2"(13mm) bolt thru the mounting hole and tighten with a phillips screwdriver.

### IMPORTANT NOTE:

Blue Loctite is recommended for threaded hardware.


**Step 6:** Once the location is finalized, tighten the mounting screw with a phillips screwdriver.


**Step 7:** If need be, rotate the speakers for best dispersion, This is easily done by locating the 5/16"(8mm) nuts on the each side of mounting band. Once located release it using a wrench (or phillips screwdriver) so that you may rotate the speaker/enclosure to the desired angle. Once there ...lock the nut down.





Rotation is limited to 70 Degrees. DO NOT exceed that range of motion!!

**Step 8:** Tie-wrap cabling. A very simple solution is to NOT drill a hole in your roll cage bar and simple tie-wrap the speaker/LED wire to the roll bar.










### WIRE ROUTING

Some wake towers allow for the wiring to be ran though the tower. Locate the desired location of the speaker, drill a 3/4" hole and route the speaker wire with the attached connector down through the wake tower. Drill a hole at the bottom and then continue to the amplifier for termination. Use a grommet when running any wire thru a metal hole.



# SPEAKER WIRE TERMINATION

R4 speakers are terminated with a waterproof DIN connector. The pigtail contains a (+) and (-) 18 AWG speaker wire. Terminate the speaker wires to the speaker wire output on the amplifier.

# **INSTALLATION CONSIDERATIONS:**

- 1. Be sure to carefully read and understand the instructions before attempting to install these speakers.
- 2. For safety, disconnect the negative battery terminal from the battery prior to beginning the installation.
- 3. For easier assembly, we suggest you have all your tools handy: drill, Allen wrench set, crimps, soldering iron, wire strippers, heat -shrink, etc.
- 4. Use high quality, waterproof connectors for a reliable installation and to minimize signal or power loss.
- 5. Think before you drill! Be careful not to cut or drill into gas tanks, fuel lines, brake or hydraulic lines, vacuum lines or electrical wiring when working on any vehicle. If installing in a boat, take care not to cut or drill through the main hull.
- 6. If possible, do not run wires near fuel lines or power. Running the wires inside the hull area provides the best protection.
- 7. Avoid running wires over or through sharp edges. Use rubber of plastic gromets to protect any wires routed through metal especially the tower.
- 8. Make sure the mounting clamps are tight before leaving the dock or cruising off-road.



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
